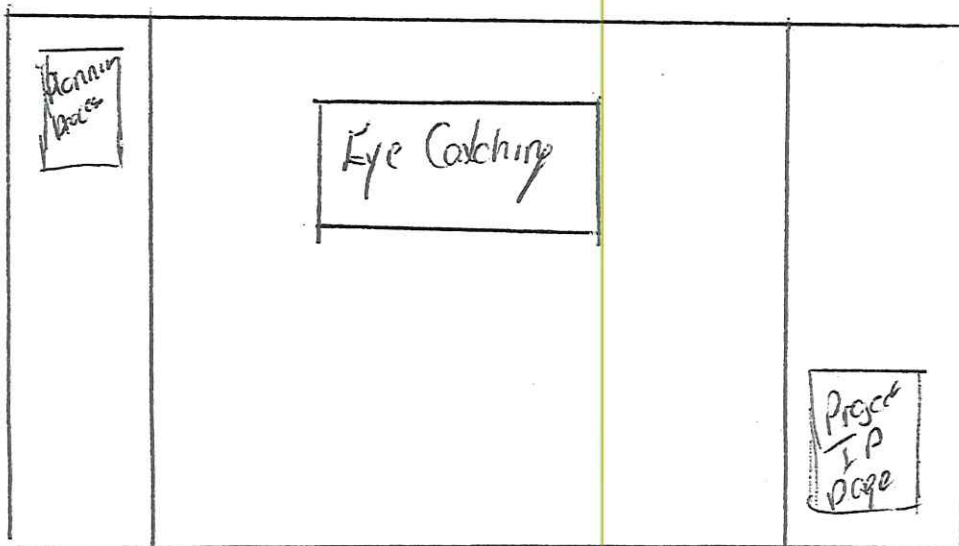
I. START EARLY

August/September

- A. Call a meeting for all students that are interested in STAR Events.
- B. Give them a copy of the Event that they are interested in.
- C. Have students develop a time line with their partner in the event and encourage them to get their parents involved.
